Water Is On The Way!

FINALLY: Construction has started on the Eastover Sanitary District's ESDII Water System. To expedite the completion, we divided it into three pipeline contracts and one water tank contract. Construction is scheduled to be completed in twelve months, so you should have water this time next year.

An inspector will place a stake at the edge of your front yard where the meter box will be installed. If you prefer another location, please contact the project engineer, Kevin Lindsay, at 639-5676. You are encouraged to pay the ESD application fee right away, if not already paid. An application form is enclosed. Those living near the District may also connect if you receive this letter.

After the system is complete and ready for use, we will mail you a letter and a form for setting up your water service account. Prior to connection, you must return the form and pay the \$125.00 application fee (if not already paid). That letter will give the dates of the six month discount period for connecting.

To connect to the system, once you've paid the necessary fees, you need to obtain a permit from Cumberland County and pay the cost to run the line from the meter box to your house. You may do the work yourself. Once your house is disconnected from your well, you may continue use of the well for outside purposes .

Property owners with a dwelling within 300 feet of a water main, who choose not to hook up, will be required to pay the availability fee and the administrative fee. Water cannot be installed on vacant lots.
